## **INFORMATION TO DATA SUBJECTS AS PER SECTION 13 LEGISLATIVE DECREE 30 JUNE 2003, N. 196**

As per Law 196 dated 30/06/2003 -the "Personal Data Protection Code"- Mollificio Valli Srl hereby provides notification about the use of Personal Data acquired in relation to current and future contractual relationships with you.

### **purpose and processing modes**

Your personal data are collected and processed in order to fulfil the obligations arising from our commercial relationship with you; in particular, such data are necessary for the following purposes: contractual, administrative, accounting and fiscal management, management of relationships with clients, suppliers, agents and representatives; management of credit recovery activities; correspondence and protocol management; customer satisfaction analysis; processing of statistics for in-house use.

Your personal data may be processed using manual and/or electronic systems in full respect of the minimum security measures required by Law 196/2003. Processing logic is closely correlated to the purpose defined above and in full respect of principles of correctness, lawfulness, transparency and protection of your confidentiality and your rights.

### **compulsory or voluntary nature of consent for data processing**

In order to stipulate the contractual relationship, consent for data processing is compulsory since legal requirements including fiscal matters must be fulfilled.

### **consequences of refusal**

Refusal will mean that Mollificio Valli Srl will be unable to carry out activities arising from or related to the execution of the contract.

### **communication of data**

Personal data will be notified to company staff appointed for their processing. They may also be notified to external subjects collaborating with Mollificio Valli Srl in the performance of its activity (e.g.: banks, suppliers, professional studios, consultants, etc.). Such processing will be limited as far as possible only to essential data for specific purposes and will be in any case carried out in full respect of standards protecting the interests of the parties concerned.

### **rights of interested parties**

There follows the complete text of Section 7 of the law in question that defines the rights of interested parties:

#### **Section 7**

*(Right to Access Personal Data and Other Rights)*

1. A data subject shall have the right to obtain confirmation as to whether or not personal data concerning him exist, regardless of their being already recorded, and communication of such data in intelligible form.
2. A data subject shall have the right to be informed
  - a) of the source of the personal data;
  - b) of the purposes and methods of the processing;
  - c) of the logic applied to the processing, if the latter is carried out with the help of electronic means;
  - d) of the identification data concerning data controller, data processors and the representative designated as per Section 5(2);
  - e) of the entities or categories of entity to whom or which the personal data may be communicated and who or which may get to know said data in their capacity as designated representative(s) in the State's territory, data processor(s) or person(s) in charge of the processing.
3. A data subject shall have the right to obtain
  - a) updating, rectification or, where interested therein, integration of the data;
  - b) erasure, anonymisation or blocking of data that have been processed unlawfully, including data whose retention is unnecessary for the purposes for which they have been collected or subsequently processed;
  - c) certification to the effect that the operations as per letters a) and b) have been notified, as also related to their contents, to the entities to whom or which the data were communicated or disseminated, unless this requirement proves impossible or involves a manifestly disproportionate effort compared with the right that is to be protected.
4. A data subject shall have the right to object, in whole or in part,
  - a) on legitimate grounds, to the processing of personal data concerning him/her, even though they are relevant to the purpose of the collection;
  - b) to the processing of personal data concerning him/her, where it is carried out for the purpose of sending advertising materials or direct selling or else for the performance of market or commercial communication surveys.

### **owner and manager of processing**

The owner of the data processing system is MOLLIFICIO VALLI Srl, electively domiciled in VIA CESERIO 39, OLEGGIO CASTELLO (NO).

May we lastly remind you that your rights as per Article 7 of Legislative Decree 30 June 2003 n. 196 are also recognised.
